

Primary School Sports Funding

The Government provides funding through the Sports Pupil Premium. For the academic year 2023/2024 the school has received £19,520.

The funding is paid directly to school to improve the quality of School Sports & PE.

The funding school receives allows children to enjoy and participate in a wider selection of sports, children are being provided with an enriched curriculum that is teaching them not only physical skills but also life skills such as leadership, team work and sportsmanship.

St Peter's RC Primary School buys into Blackburn Rovers Community Trust who provide quality PE lessons, working alongside teachers and lead after school sports clubs throughout the year.

PE lessons follow the National Curriculum.

After school clubs provide different sports throughout the year.

The school also buys into BwD competition package which allows us to enter competitive competitions throughout the year.

We hire an on-site swimming pool each year for four weeks. This is supervised by qualified swimming instructors, children are taught in small groups. This proved a great success with 95% of our Year 6 children being able to swim 25 metres competently, using a range of strokes effectively. Children were also taught safe self-rescue in different water-based situations.

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
